If your Early Career Teacher (ECT) is beginning statutory induction in the Summer Term, they will follow UCL's Summer Starter Programme before joining the main programme in the Autumn. ## Access to UCL Extend

## Access to local clusters

- ELTSH will inform the Induction Tutor and ECT/ Mentor which local cluster they will join from September.

## Welcome

- New participants will be invited to a welcome event on 21st April where we will provide further guidance on the key activities in the summer term. Please note these are different from the activities other ECTs are engaged in.
- The ECT will join the main programme in Autumn, starting with Module 1.
