What is IOE Lead Partner Direct?

IOE Lead Partner Direct (IOE LPD) is a postgraduate fee-funded route into initial teacher training that is run in partnership between IOE, UCL's Faculty of Education and Society, and a Lead Partner school. It is only for applicants wanting to teach in primary or secondary schools. UCL IOE has overall responsibility for the programme.

Who is IOE LPD for?

Applicants who apply for IOE LPD often do so because they want to learn to teach in a specific primary or secondary school, and to gain employment there at the end of the course. This may be because they live locally or already have experience working in that school.

How is IOE LPD different to UCL's other Primary and Secondary PGCE Programmes?

IOE LPD follows the same structure as the core PGCE route. Student teachers attend teaching days at IOE alongside other student teachers on the core PGCE. However, IOE LPD is different to the core PGCE in that

- applicants apply directly to the Lead Partner school and not UCL and
- ii. the Lead Partner will arrange your contrasting teaching placements.

What qualifications will I get?

Successful completion of the programme leads to a Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) awarded by UCL and Qualified Teacher Status (QTS).

Course structure, fees and entry requirements

IOE LPD has the same fees, course structure and entry requirements as our core Primary and Secondary PGCE Programmes.
